1. Executive Summary

In 2025, The Bridge of Hope Foundation continued its dedicated mission to support vulnerable children and empower local communities. Thanks to the generosity of our donors and strategic partners, our total income for the fiscal year reached **KSh 6,450,000**. Every shilling was carefully deployed to provide direct care, education, healthcare, and administrative oversight to ensure long-term sustainability and the wellbeing of every child under our care.

2. Key Program Highlights & Achievements

- **Daily Care & Welfare:** Maintained full room, board, clothing, and nutritional needs for all resident children throughout the year, ensuring a safe and nurturing home environment.
- **Education & Learning:** Supported primary and secondary education expenses, including tuition, uniforms, and learning materials, achieving zero dropout rates among program participants.
- **Healthcare & Medical Safety:** Secured comprehensive health coverage and regular medical consultations for all beneficiaries under our care.
- **Caregiver Support:** Employed and retained dedicated caregivers who provide consistent daily supervision, emotional support, and mentorship to the children.

3. Financial Breakdown (Fiscal Year 2025)

Our accounts are independently audited by **Wilson Lemayian**, Certified Public Accountant (CPA-K). The figures below are drawn from the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2025.

4. Governance & Independent Audit

Our financial records for the fiscal year 2025 were independently audited by Wilson Lemayian, CPA-K. The auditor confirmed that the financial statements present a true and fair view of the Foundation's financial position and performance, and that funds were applied in accordance with the organization's objectives and applicable regulatory requirements in Kenya.

5. Looking Ahead to 2026

- Expand our educational sponsorship program to reach at least 20 additional children.
- Enhance vocational training modules for older youth transitioning into adulthood and independent living.
- Strengthen community outreach and family-support programs to promote sustainable care models.
- Continue rigorous financial transparency and independent annual audits.
